A TRIBUTE TO NINA SIMONE

Love Me or Leave Me is a musical exploration with interwoven heartfelt stories of the life, loves and passions of the legendary NINA SIMONE. Artistic Director, Narrator and Vocalist, Christine Manetta tells Nina Simone's story through anecdote and monologue accompanied by a stellar collection of Melbourne's most seasoned musicians, including renowned Jazz pianist Adam Rudegeair, they pay homage to Nina.



Focusing on the Jazz and Blues Elements of Simone's work, originating from Traditional African American Folk Music, which Nina gave her own musical colour too and reimagining the genre of Tribal Jazz that has been inspired by Nina's works. Christine's own distinctive style is passionately driven towards political, activist art, as she beautifully portrays Nina Simone's songs giving them a spin of her own. Filled with sultry tones, a deep voice, she exposes the human spirit.

A musical journey from Tribal Gospel Beginnings and Cabaret Jazz to Activist Anthems and 60's Flower Power Hippie Songs. Including songs such as I Put a Spell on You, Feelin Good, Sinnerman, See-Line Woman, Ain't Got No-I Got Life and My Baby Just Cares for Me.

In 2014 the project of Love Me or Leave Me - A Tribute to Nina Simone became a reality and since has been creating social, racial and cultural awareness. Winning acclaim, with a successful tour, throughout Regional Victoria/New South Wales and Melbourne's Cabaret Scene, including the Albury Entertainment Centre, Bendigo Engine Room, Port Fairy Theatre, Castlemaine Jazz Festival and Halls Gap Jazz & Blues Festival.

Nina Simone's unique blend of jazz, classical music and blues won her an audience, earning her cult status and critical acclaim. Nina used her remarkable talent to create a legacy of liberation and empowerment through a magnificent body of works, recording 50 Albums and 500 songs throughout a career spanning over fifty years.

Nina Simone was not interested in Glitz and Glamour but was a Gusty and Resilient Diva. Acknowledging Nina's racial struggles but also seeing more how she performed for the freedom of female voices which went beyond race and for the Justice of Social, Political and Economic Struggles. She empowered all people oppressed through her example; an inspiration to many even today.
